SAN FRANCISCO Prison officials have secured a fresh supply of a lethal injection drug they ran out of last week that contributed to the cancellation of California's first execution in nearly five years.

In a court filing Wednesday, the state Attorney General's office told U.S. District Court Judge Jeremy Fogel it had secured 12 grams of sodium thiopental with an expiration date in 2014. The state called off the execution of Albert Greenwood Brown on Thursday after two significant legal setbacks and the expiration of its entire seven-gram supply of the drug that night.

The court filing said it obtained the new drug on Thursday, but didn't elaborate on why it couldn't be used in the planned execution.

The filing also didn't say where the state obtained the drug. In previous court filings, government lawyers said they didn't expect a new shipment until the first of the year.
