CALL & WRITE THEM



MEET THEM IN PERSON

imes TIP 1

Know the name of your legislator.



Plan out what you will say. Be prepared to provide your home address.

(V) TIP 3

Remember to mention the bill number & why you are contacting your legislator. (i.e. "Vote yes on SB xxxx!")

imes TIP 4

Make it short and sweet.

◯ TIP 5

Tell a personal story, if you have one.

(<) TIP 6

Frame the problem, solution, & action.
