CALIFORNIA PUBLIC RECORDS ACT REQUEST

The Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office (LADA) is in receipt of your California Public Records Act (PRA) request dated July 29, 2019, seeking:

"copies of the following materials in the agency's possession, regardless of who wrote them, from 1990 onwards: 1. Any training materials related to jury selection; 2. Any training materials related to the constitutional requirements under Batson v. Kentucky and People v. Wheeler, including training materials related to handling Batson-Wheeler claims or motion."

Pursuant to Government Code section 6253(c), the LADA needs an additional 14 calendar days to complete its search for and review of records. The additional time is necessary to search for, collect and appropriately examine a voluminous amount of separate and distinct records.

The LADA will respond on or before August 22, 2019.
