None of these students has any criminal history in the City of Fairfield and none is a suspect in a criminal investigation.

As a result of discussions with the parents of the students who were involved, the Fairfield Police Department and the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District will be adopting policies to clarify the procedures for law enforcement activities on campus.
