Search Warrants, Probation/Parole Searches

• The TETF II has conducted or assisted 15+ searches, excluding Stingray operations.

Recoveries

• The TETF II has recovered or assisted in the recovery of 75+ firearms.

Significant Accomplishments

- TETF I continued to support the Alameda County's prosecutions from 2008's Nutcracker wiretap investigation.
- TETF I was also instrumental in obtaining and performing wiretap investigations in the high-profile murder investigations, such as the Hassani Campbell case.
- TETF I continued to be a leader in the field of electronic surveillance to include vehicle trackers and Pen Registers, which provided information which often proved to be invaluable in ongoing narcotics and violent crime investigations.
